Instrument Pre-Loan Check and Confirmation of Agreement & Terms and Conditions

- The instrument supplied by SVCS will be in serviceable condition, with any cosmetic damages identified. If you find there are areas of damage not listed, please notify the school within a week of receiving the instrument
- SVCS will nominate a total loss value for the instrument. This is the figure required to purchase an instrument of similar quality should the loaned instrument be damaged beyond repair or lost by the student. This is also the figure you may use for insurance purposes
- The instrument will be for the sole benefit of the named student.
- As a parent/carer, you are agreeing to keep the instrument in a serviceable condition, repairing any damage (reasonable 'wear and tear' is acceptable) and replacing consumable items e.g. strings, reeds, electrical leads, drum-skins etc. as required.
- By signing this agreement, your child is agreeing to participate in the wider musical life of the school through commitment to relevant extra-curricular music activities
- Instruments should be returned to the Music department if no longer required or the student leaves SVCS
- This agreement will be reviewed annually, when the school may choose to revalue the instrument in line with the prevailing market conditions
