The full document is available on request. Following a successful first four weeks back at school, we do not want to be complacent. Please do go over the guidance with your son or daughter again.

Key points on hygiene are below: Washing and sanitising is encouraged frequently throughout the day.

Every classroom will be equipped with cleaning/sanitising equipment to be used in the last 5 minutes of each lesson.

Enhanced cleaning regime is in operation, with 'high-touch' areas prioritised.

In addition, we **recommend** the responsible wearing of face coverings by students and staff when they are in indoor communal areas (hall, corridors, toilets, queuing for lunch) of the school to further reduce the risk of Covid-19 transmission. Some staff may wear visors in classrooms, in line with individual risk assessments.

The wearing of face masks is mandatory on public transport and recommended on school buses.

Year 11 Post-16 Information

The Year 11 students should now start to look at their post-16 options for next year, it will come round very quickly! Due to the current situation, we are unable to hold whole year assemblies, so we have asked each post-16 provider to send us a presentation which the tutors will show during tutor time. Prospectuses are being sent in the next few weeks and we will advise you of the open evenings (these will be virtual) in due course. We would like all students to have applied to their chosen college/sixth form by Christmas. Students can apply for more than one course, with more than one provider.
