Local COVID Alert Levels

General guidance for the public on the new COVID Alert Levels (medium, high and very high) can be found here. Stour Valley Community School is in a medium alert level area, so no changes for us currently.

The DfE has confirmed that in areas at Local COVID Alert Level *High* or Local COVID Alert Level *Very High*, the DfE expects that education and childcare providers will normally remain open for all pupils, with the additional expectation that where pupils in year 7 and above are educated, face coverings should be worn by adults and pupils when moving around the premises, outside of classrooms, such as in corridors and communal areas where social distancing cannot easily be maintained.

Accordingly, DfE guidance has been updated to refer to the new alert levels, including:

Protective measures for holiday or after-school clubs and other out-of-school settings for children during the coronavirus (COVID-19) outbreak
