Activity Afternoons come to SVCS

What a strange year it has been. During most academic years, Stour Valley Community School students would have been able to take part in a raft of Period 6 activities as well as visits in the UK and overseas.

Staff at Stour Valley Community School would like to try and address this and provide every student with some time out of the usual curriculum and help them experience something different over the next few weeks. The plans for these 'Activity Afternoons' are now well underway and the staff are working hard to develop some fantastic opportunities for everyone. The aim is for the whole school to go 'off timetable' for one afternoon each week and try something different, work together as a team and learn some new skills.

When will they be?

One afternoon each week on different days. Initial dates: Mon June, Tuesday 15 June, Wednesday 23 June, Thurs 1 July, Fri 9 July, Mon 12 July. As so many of the activities are outside, we expect to move some of these dates in the event of wet weather. If this happens we will let you know.

What are the activities?

Students will take part in 6 different activities over the 6 week half term. One activity each week. The activities have been selected for each year group and include some sport, team building, relaxation and creative tasks too. More on these to follow in the next few days. **How will students be grouped?**

Students will be in the same groups they have for Technology subjects. Year 10 students will be in groups similar to the Technology groups they had in Year 9. Each group will not contain any more than 20 students.

What will they need?

All students to wear PE kit on the days when they have an 'Activity Afternoon'. We recommend they bring in a water bottle. A hat and sun cream will be needed for outdoor activities. Lunch as usual.

How long will the activities last?

After lunch (1:35pm) until 3pm. All within the school day with usual transport home.

How much will the activities cost?

No cost to parents and carers.

What happens next?

Students will be given a timetable of their 6 activities next week. There will also be a short video explaining the activities during form time before they leave for the half term break on 28 May.

How can I support?

The activities have been selected because they are appropriate for your child's year group. There will be some activities that some students will find easy, others more difficult and some out of their comfort zone. This is all part of wanting to provide the opportunity to try new things. Keeping an open mind and encouraging everyone to try something new will ensure that students get the most out of these opportunities. Your support in this will be invaluable.
