



Summary of 2018 Examination Performance Measures

The following data outlines the key performance indicators following the Summer 2018 examinations. In 2018, the reformed GCSEs were graded using a 9-1 scale, with 9 being the highest grade. Other subjects were graded using A*-G, with the following results being a combination of both measures.
