As part of the GCSE Geography course, we are required to conduct fieldwork in a rural setting. This allows the students to collect data and interrogate it in preparation for their GCSE exam. DESTINATION: Clare Town

DATES: Tuesday 30 January and Friday 2 February

There is no cost to attend the trip. Students will be walking down to two areas within the town during their normal lesson times and returning in time for their next lesson.

Due to this being within normal school hours, full school uniform will be required, however, if students wish to bring a change of shoes to wear during the visit, then they are welcome to do so.
