We would like to invite your child to attend a Languages event at the Anglo European School in Ingatestone, Essex on Monday 17 June, we are pleased to confirm there is no charge for this visit.

We will travel by minibus, leaving school at 8:00am and returning by 4:30pm, therefore, arrangements will need to be made to collect your child from SVCS. While some refreshments will be provided, your child will need to bring a packed lunch (provided by us if your child receives Free School Meals).

We are aware that there are some Year 10 exams on this day, and these will be rescheduled for this group of students on the trip to enable them to attend this special event.

The event is entitled 'Languages - On Doctor's Orders' and we would like to send a French and a Spanish team from Year 10. Here is information from the organisers about this event:

We would like to invite you to join us at Beeleigh Language Hub's first inter-school event, which will take place here at Anglo European School on **Monday 17 June 2024 between 9:30am and 3:00pm**.

The event is based around the career and university aspirations of our students and will be split into two halves:

During the morning we will host a Careers Workshop with Business Language Champions:

- The theme of this will be using languages in the World Health Organisation.
- The workshop will include a keynote talk from the World Health Organisation and opportunities to practise spontaneous speaking, writing and listening as students create their own international public health campaign.
- Students will then compete in their school teams (see below) with prizes awarded to the winners.

In the afternoon, **students will hear from a university representative** who will talk to them about what it is like to study Languages at university, concluding with the students being offered the opportunity to ask any related questions they may have.

We will provide refreshments during breaktime for students but would ask that students bring along their own packed lunch.

We hope your child will find this an exciting and inspiring opportunity and that they will make the most of the chance to meet and work with other able Language students from a range of schools in our region.
