Departure & Return	Departing at 8:30am and returning at 4:30pm, via coach (we kindly request that transport arrangements are made to collect your child from SVCS at 4:30pm)

The purpose of the visit is for students to explore the work of key designers and to prepare for the start of Design Technology Year 11 NEA which begins on the week of the trip and contributes to 50% of the overall GCSE.

Students can wear non-uniform suitable for this visit, whilst still adhering to the usual no jewellery, makeup, skirt/trouser/length and crop-top uniform policies, as we will be representing the school.

We kindly request that your child is provided a packed lunch and drink(s) (non-fizzy) for the day. Please note that the option to order food/drinks via delivery services such as *Deliveroo/Uber Eats* is not permitted.

The cost of the visit is £18 per student, this covers the coach/fuel only as entry to the museum is of no cost.
