His keen interest in the armed forces was reflected by members of the Royal British Legion and serving army personnel from Rocks Barracks in Woodbridge leading a procession of the school community into the hall. The celebration of Haydn's life was conducted by Reverend Paul Graham with him making reference to Haydn's enjoyment of strategy games, Dungeons and Dragons and his sense of fun. Shared memories included times from primary school, reflections from Haydn's teachers and special moments recalled by his friendship group.

Mr Stephens, Teacher said "students put together an event to celebrate the life of their friend and it has been a special time to work with them to make this into a reality. I could not be more proud of their mature approach to honouring Haydn"

Miss Bank, Deputy Headteacher said "in one way or another, our whole community has been affected by Haydn's death. Purple Day has brought everyone together and allowed us to pay tribute to Haydn and the positive impact he has had on so many lives."

You will be taken as a person not needed.


You are boycotted or avoided.

School Lottery


