round to the entrance between the Art and Food rooms. Testing will take place in G6, exactly as on previous occasions. The students may need to wait, if there is a queue, but the new nasal swab tests are quicker than the previous tests and the students are familiar with the system so we do not anticipate a long wait. If you have already given consent for your child to take a test here, we will continue to use that. If you have given consent but wish to withdraw it, please update this via the SIMS Parent app or email keady@stourvalley.org and do not send your child in for testing. We would encourage everyone who can participate to do so as this testing has identified a number of asymptomatic cases: testing helps keep us all safe.
