Like most commercial businesses providing essential services we have been affected by increases in all our costs and regrettably we need to increase our fares on 31 October. The fares at Chambers were last increased in March 2020. On-bus fares have increased in line with inflation since their last increase. Single and return tickets will not increase by more than 60p.

Weekly tickets are frozen. 16-19 tickets are frozen. Endeavour tickets will increase though. App tickets are frozen, as we want to encourage more people to use the App and speed up loading times to give everyone a better service. Anywhere Weekly tickets on the App are reduced.

We have had to revise our Kid for £1.20 single Saturdays offer which was available to 16-19s and Child fare classes. Saturday singles will now be £2 for 16-19s and £1.50 for a Child. This is still a discount compared to singles charged in the week.

A new Sudbury town zone tickets available on the App. Includes Long Melford and Great Cornard.
