## **Ski Trip 2023**

After the disappointment of having to cancel this year's Ski Trip due to Covid-19, I am pleased to announce that we have started planning our next trip. This trip will take place during February half term 2023 and will be to the **Artesina/Prato Nevoso** ski areas in **Italy**. The Artesina/Prato Nevoso areas are situated in the Maritime Alps and have an excellent snowfall record due to their geographical positioning. The ski area is also 95% covered by state-of-the-art snow cannons, ensuring quality skiing even in milder conditions.

As previously promised we are happy to offer those students who were due to join us on this year's cancelled Ski trip a guaranteed place. However, this will still leave a considerable number of places available for students new to SVCS or those students who did not apply for this year's trip. We will again be looking to take 45 students (with the possibility this time of taking more if the demand exists), and any student currently in **Years 7-10** may apply for a place on the trip (previous skiing experience is **not** necessary). The trip will include executive coach travel and full board accommodation, evening entertainment, lift passes, winter sports insurance, skiing tuition with professional instructors, hire of equipment and helmets. All booked through Halsbury, a highly reputable and trusted travel company who are fully ABTA and ATOL bonded and offer a Covid guarantee.

Having been involved in a number of school ski trips over the last few years I am aware that many parents/carers and students will have questions about the trip. In order to answer any questions you may have. there will be an information evening for students and parents/carers in the school hall on **Thursday 7 October from 6-7pm**, during which we shall provide further details on the trip. We will be distributing letters to those interested at the end of the meeting which informs parents/carers about the next step for selection, therefore, we advise that you attend should you wish your child to be considered for a place.
