This morning I met representatives from local education and public health about COVID rates in our school. They support my decision to put some year groups onto online learning for next week. This is to break the chain of transmission that is apparent in some year groups and to protect our staff. With the school breaking for half term next Friday, 22 October, this will provide a two-week break in the chain of transmission.

As of today, we have 33 students who have tested positive and this is quite a jump from the end of last week - at least doubling in Years 7, 8 and 11 and hitting the threshold for linked cases in Year 11 and Year 8.

We have 6 staff who have tested positive for COVID and have all been pretty unwell. We also have staff off with other flu-like/chest infection symptoms. There are 9 teaching staff off and being covered today.

The decision as to which year groups to put onto online learning is being made based on the rates of infection: Years 7, 8 and 11. I do not take the decision lightly. I am confident that our staff will deliver quality online lessons based on the success of online learning in the Spring Term of last year. All of Year 7 have now been inducted on using Teams.

We will organise Free School Meals for the families that receive them and will communicate with them separately.

I intend to visit each Year 7, 8 and 11 class in person this afternoon and explain what is happening and why.

In addition, I am recommending mask wearing for staff and students (Year 9 and 10) who are in school next week – in communal areas and classrooms. Staff will also be reminding everyone of their responsibility for good hygiene and following measures in place as part of our COVID risk assessment.

If your child is unwell, please do not send them into school. We are seeing an increase in colds and flu-like illnesses, as well as an increase in children testing positive for COVID.

Decisions I have made this week have not been easy and I hope that you understand and support my chosen course of action.
