Uniform Checks - Advanced Notice

In assembly this week students have been reminded of school's expectations in a number of areas. This is part of a general drive towards re-establishing 'pre-covid' routines within the school. As part of this

information, students were informed of a strategy we will be implementing after Easter with the intention of bringing standards of uniform back in line with what was expected before it became necessary for students to attend school in PE kit, and the inconsistency of uniform standard that this inevitably led to.

For your purposes at home you need to be aware that Year Leaders will be supporting tutors in conducting uniform checks immediately after we return from the Easter break. We would appreciate your support in ensuring that students return after Easter appropriately dressed for school, hence giving plenty of advanced notice of these measures. Any accessories/jewellery etc. that students should not be wearing will be confiscated at the initial uniform check and will be subject to the same rules as mobile phones when they are confiscated.

Staff will also be compiling lists of any students who are not in correct uniform. You will be contacted if your child's uniform is incorrect, and we would expect this to be rectified before Year Leaders return to check forms the following week. After this point we will be applying escalating sanctions for defiance of school rules for any students where uniform remains uncompliant.

Ultimately, students know if they are wearing the correct uniform or not. They know if their skirt doesn't remain at knee length; they know if they are wearing athletic footwear; black jeans or jogging bottoms etc. If these or any other uniform discrepancies apply, then students should not be surprised to be challenged on this after Easter.

Thank you for your ongoing support in upholding the high standards of the school.

Students who travel to and from school by bus are reminded that they should not travel on public or school buses if they have tested positive for Covid-19, and whilst face coverings are no longer mandatory, students should always take care to keep themselves and other passengers safe by continuing to follow sensible precautions.
