#### **COVID-19 Government Guidance**

From 11 January in England, people who receive positive lateral flow (LFT) test results for coronavirus (COVID-19) will be required to self-isolate immediately and won't be required to take a confirmatory PCR test.

Lateral flow tests are taken by people who do not have COVID-19 symptoms. Anyone who develops 1 of the 3 main COVID-19 symptoms should stay at home and self-isolate and take a PCR test. They must self-isolate if they get a positive test result, even if they have had a recent negative lateral flow test – these rules have not changed.

The 10 day self isolation period for people who record a positive LFT result for COVID-19 has been reduced to 7 days in most circumstances, unless you cannot test for any reason.

Individuals may now take lateral flow tests on day 6 and day 7 of their self-isolation period. Those who receive two negative test results are no longer required to complete 10 full days of self-isolation. The first test must be taken no earlier than day 6 of the self-isolation period and tests must be taken 24 hours apart. If both these test results are negative, and you do not have a high temperature, you may end your self-isolation after the second negative test result and return to your education setting from day 7.

Anyone who has tested positive with Covid in the last 90 days should now take regular lateral flow tests.

Please would you ensure that you upload the result of the twice weekly lateral flow tests to the Test Register portal. You should receive a reminder email on Thursday and Sunday. Unfortunately, we are not notified by the NHS when a positive result is reported to them.
