This was such a kind and generous act which shows what lovely students we have here at Stour Valley.


HPV & Meningitis Catch-up Vaccinations

New Year Reading Solutions


Not sure what book to pick up in January? Here are some suggestions for students in KS3 which align with what they will be learning in the English classroom:










Year 8: Secret and Legends- Spring 1 SVCS English Department Recommends...
