COVID-19 Government Guidance

From Monday 17 January, people who are self-isolating with COVID-19 will have the option to reduce their isolation period after 5 full days if they test negative with a lateral flow device (LFD) test on both day 5 and day 6 and they do not have a temperature. For example, if they test negative on the morning of day 5 and the morning of day 6, they can return to their education or childcare setting immediately on day 6.

The first test must be taken no earlier than day 5 of the self-isolation period, and the second must be taken the following day. All test results should be <u>reported to NHS Test and Trace</u> and uploaded to the Test Register site.

If the result of either of their tests is positive, they should continue to selfisolate until they get negative results from two LFD tests on consecutive Year 11 Parents/Carers Evening via school cloud, 5-7pm

days or until they have completed 10 full days of self-isolation, whichever is earliest.

Anyone who is unable to take LFD tests or anyone who continues to have a temperature will need to complete the full 10 day period of self-isolation.

Please would you ensure that you upload the result of the twice weekly lateral flow tests to the Test Register portal. You should receive a reminder email on Thursday and Sunday. Unfortunately, we are not notified by the NHS when a positive result is reported to them. If your son or daughter has a positive PCR test please forward the result email to keady@stourvalley.org
