School Uniform Updated for September 2025

We have made updates to our uniform policy for the next academic year. As many of you will be buying new uniform over the summer break we have included some of the key changes to ensure you purchase the correct uniform. Our full uniform policy can be found on our website, please see the key updates :

- Black socks only to be worn with the uniform, no other sock colour is appropriate
- An optional grey fitted jumper is now available to replace the royal blue uniform jumpers.
- Pleated skirts are the only skirt to be worn, no straight skirts can be worn.
- A new PE ³/₄ zip jumper is available to purchase as it has been updated to a sports-appropriate material. We are phasing out the rugby shirt and sweatshirt, replacing them with the new quarter zip top.
- False lashes are not allowed to be worn, a small amount of makeup can be worn provided it is discrete.
