Uniform Update 23-27 June

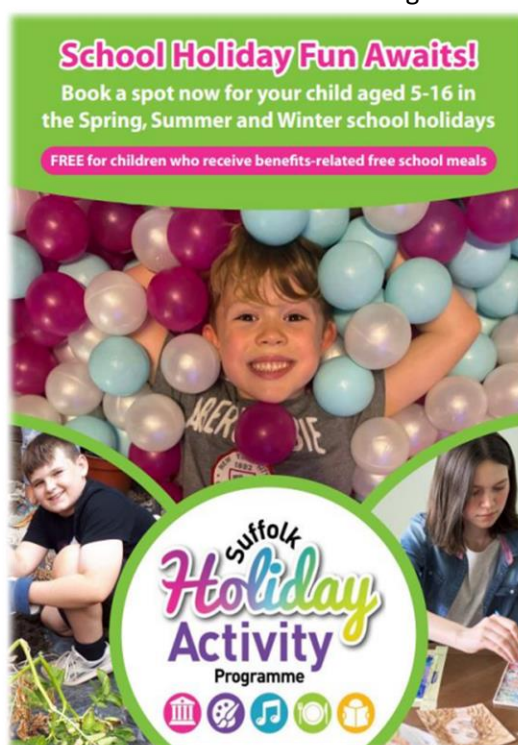
Due to the continued hot weather forecast this coming week (Monday 23 - Friday 27 June), there will be no expectation to wear ties or blazers.
