I write to inform you of a trip opportunity, available to Year 10 GCSE Resistant Materials and Graphics students, the details are as follows:

Destination	The Design Museum London
Date	Tuesday 6 June 2023
Departure & Return	Departing at 8:30am and returning at 4:30pm, via coach (we kindly request that transport arrangements are made to collect your child from SVCS at 4:30pm)

The coach will be travelling directly to and from the museum, and we plan to spend approximately 2-3 hours there. Students will complete the first page of their On-Exam Assessment, a project that will account for 50% of their overall grade for the subject, and it is hoped that the visit will be very inspirational.

Students can wear non-uniform suitable for this visit, whilst still adhering to the usual no jewellery, makeup, skirt/trouser/length and crop-top uniform policies, as we will be presenting the school.

We kindly request that your child is provided a packed lunch and drink(s) (non-fizzy) for the day. It is vital that packed lunch/snacks are nut-free. Students may wish to also bring a small amount of spending money for the gift shop, *however the products on offer are usually of an inflated price*. Students may wish to bring phones and cameras to take pictures of information for their portfolios, though we expect these to be used within school guidelines, and any loss or damage is not of the schools responsibility. Staff will be more than happy to take photos for students if requested.

The cost of the visit is £16 per student, this covers the coach/fuel only as entry to the museum is of no cost. Please note that Payment is required via ParentPay where you can also confirm your consent.

Please note that as with all trips and excursions, we are expecting the usual high SVCS standards of behaviour leading up to and on this trip. Any student who fails to meet these expectations risks removal from the trip and will be dealt with in line with the school's Behaviour Policy.
