End of Year 11 and Formal Day

Please be advised that Friday 23 May will be the last formal day for Year 11 students at school. On this day, students will sit their English exam in the morning, followed by a special Leavers Assembly. After the assembly, students will be free to leave the school site. Further details about the day's schedule will be provided closer to the time.

Attendance Expectations
